Union Certification Program

January 28, 2011

A five-hour training for Union negotiators on how to make contracts LGBT-inclusive. Training includes a review of model contract language including the most up-to-date non-discrimination language, domestic partner benefits, inclusive family leave language, and transgender health benefits. The training will include both economic and non-economic changes that can be made to make union contracts more LGBT-inclusive, and will discuss messaging and provide resource materials for supporting leaders & educating members.

LGBT Labor Leadership Training

January 28 (evening) and 29 (day), 2011

A ten-hour interactive class led by skilled facilitators from Pride at Work's National office will train participants to develop organizing and leadership skills to effectively raise and address LGBT issues in their workplaces and in their unions and build a stronger labor movement together for all workers. Training includes group dinner and panel discussion with local labor leaders.
